How Then Should We Live?

Memorial Day 2024 May 26, 2024 John 15:13, Hebrews 11

<u>John 15:13</u>, Greater love has no one than this: <u>to lay down</u> <u>one's life</u> for one's friends.

John 8:36, So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

<u>1 Peter 2:16</u>, Live as <u>free people</u>, but <u>do not use your freedom</u> <u>as a cover-up for evil</u>; live as God's slaves. **17** Show proper respect to everyone, love the family of believers, fear God, honor the emperor.

Romans 8:35, Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?... 37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. 38 For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, 39 neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Hebrews 11:1, Now <u>faith</u> is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. **2** This is what the ancients were commended for.

How Then Should We Live?

1) By Letting Your Life Be a Sacrifice to GOD

Hebrews 11:4, By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead.

2) By Following God When You Don't Know Where It Will LEAD

<u>Hebrews 11:8</u>, By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though <u>he did not know where he was going</u>.

3) By Choosing God's Path Over Your Personal COMFORT

Hebrews 11:24, By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. 25 He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. 26 He regarded disgrace for the sake of Christ as of greater value than the treasures of Egypt, because he was looking ahead to his reward.

4) By Believing God for Victory Over Your CIRCUMSTANCES

Hebrews 11:32, And what more shall I say? I do not have time to tell about Gideon, Barak, Samson and Jephthah, about David and Samuel and the prophets, 33 who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, and gained what was promised; who shut the mouths of lions, 34 quenched the fury of the flames, and escaped the edge of the sword; whose weakness was turned to strength; and who became powerful in battle and routed foreign armies.
