God's Heart for Us! Matters of the Heart, Pt. 8 2 Samuel 7 July 30, 2023

2 Samuel 7:17, Nathan reported to David all the words of this entire revelation. 18 Then King David went in and sat before the LORD, and he said: "Who am I, Sovereign LORD, and what is my family, that you have brought me this far? 19 And as if this were not enough in your sight, Sovereign LORD, you have also spoken about the future of the house of your servant—and this decree, Sovereign LORD, is for a mere human!

1. David's Big IDEA

2 Samuel 7:1, After the king was settled in his palace and the LORD had given him rest from all his enemies around him, 2 he said to Nathan the prophet, "Here I am, living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God remains in a tent."

3 Nathan replied to the king, "Whatever you have in mind, go ahead and do it, for the LORD is with you."

2. God Pauses the PROJECT

2 Samuel 7:4, But that night the word of the LORD came to Nathan, saying: 5 "Go and tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD says: Are you the one to build me a house to dwell in? 6 I have not dwelt in a house from the day I brought the Israelites up out of Egypt to this day. I have been moving from place to place with a tent as my dwelling. 7 Wherever I have moved with all the Israelites, did I ever say to any of their rulers whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, "Why have you not built me a house of cedar?"

3. God Reminds David Who Made Him GREAT

<u>2 Samuel 7:8</u>, "Now then, tell my servant David, 'This is what the LORD Almighty says: <u>I took you from the pasture</u>, from tending the flock, and <u>appointed you ruler over my people Israel</u>. **9** I have been <u>with you wherever you have gone</u>, and <u>I have cut off all your enemies</u> from before you...

1 Corinthians 4:7, For who makes you different from anyone else? What do you have that you did not receive? And if you did receive it, why do you boast as though you did not?

4. God Has a Better Plan for EVERYONE

2 Samuel 7:9, ...Now I will make your name great, like the names of the greatest men on earth. 10 And I will provide a place for my people Israel and will plant them so that they can have a home of their own and no longer be disturbed... 11 "The LORD declares to you that the LORD himself will establish a house for you:

5. God Unveils His Plan for the TEMPLE

<u>2 Samuel 7:12</u>, When your days are over and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your offspring to succeed you, your own flesh and blood, and I will establish his kingdom. <u>13 He is the one who will build a house for my Name</u>, and I will establish the throne of <u>his kingdom</u> forever.

1 Chronicles 22:6, Then he called for his son Solomon and charged him to <u>build a house for the LORD</u>, the God of Israel. 7 David said to Solomon: "My son, <u>I had it in my heart to build a house</u> for the Name of the LORD my God. 8 But this word of the LORD came to me: 'You have

shed much blood and have fought many wars. You are not to build a house for my Name...

6. God Shares His Blueprint for the **FUTURE**

2 Samuel 7:14, I will be his father, and he will be my son. When he does wrong, I will punish him with a rod wielded by men, with floggings inflicted by human hands. 15 But my love will never be taken away from him... 16 Your house and your kingdom will endure forever before me; your throne will be established forever."

7. David Confidently Prays for God's Will to BE DONE

2 Samuel 7:27, "LORD Almighty, God of Israel, you have revealed this to your servant, saying, 'I will build a house for you.' So your servant has found courage to pray this prayer to you. 28 Sovereign LORD, you are God! Your covenant is trustworthy, and you have promised these good things to your servant. 29 Now be pleased to bless the house of your servant, that it may continue forever in your sight; for you, Sovereign LORD, have spoken, and with your blessing the house of your servant will be blessed forever."

Isaiah 9:6, For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. 7 Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over his kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this.

Numbers 23:19, God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?

Luke 1:26, ...God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee, 27 to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary. 28 The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you." ... 38 "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled."

Acts 13:34, God raised him from the dead so that he will never be subject to decay. As God has said, "I will give you the holy and sure blessings promised to David."

Revelation 21:1, Then I saw "a new heaven and a new earth," for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. 2 I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. 3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people, and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 4 'He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death' or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." 5 He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" Then he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."
