Jesus Is Your New Start Good News, Pt. 5 2 Corinthians 5 December 30 and 31, 2023

<u>2 Corinthians 5:1,</u> For we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:4,</u> For while we are in this tent we groan and are burdened...

<u>2 Corinthians 5:5</u>, Now the one who has fashioned us for this very purpose is God, who has given us the Spirit as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:8</u>, We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:11</u>, Since then, we know what it is to fear the Lord, we try to persuade others...

<u>2 Corinthians 5:13</u>, If we are "out of our mind," as some say, it is for God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:14</u>, For Christ's love compels us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:15</u>, And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

<u>Matthew 16:25</u>, For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:16</u>, So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:17</u>, Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

<u>2 Corinthians 5:18</u>, All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:19</u>, That God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.

<u>Colossians 2:13,</u> ...God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:20</u>, We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:21, God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.</u>
